Located approximately 15km north of Sydney Airport, takes about 25 minutes.

- Child 5 to 15 years of age. Children under 5 years are free of charge. Children aged 15 and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- This tour is not wheelchair/pram accessible as this is a walking tour with 300+ steps.
- Opera House stages lots of live performances, so venues are subject to availability at the time of your tour.
- Opera House can't store suitcases or large bags. Bags larger than A4 size will need to be cloaked before you can go on the tour.
- Videoing is not allowed.
- There are plenty of photo opportunities - your tour guide will advise you if photos are not to be taken at any point.
- Mobile phones are permitted on the tour however please ensure they are switched off or on silent for the duration of the tour.
- Wear comfortable shoes, as this is a walking tour with 200+ steps.

Sydney Opera House 1 Hour Architectural Tour - English

The Sydney Opera House is one of the world's most recognisable landmarks and this is your chance to truly get up-close. Run your hands over the world-famous shell tiles, take a seat in the elegant custom-made white birch timber chairs and marvel at the vaulted ceilings. Visit areas off-limits to the public and capture photographs from rare vantage points. Explore theatres and foyers where more than 1600 concerts, operas, dramas and ballets take place each year.
